Subject:- Payment of grants to the Educational & Vocational Institutions run by the R.K.Mission in Tripura

Sir,

I am directed to say that Ramkrishna Mission, Belur Math, agreed to set up and manage educational and other institutions of public utility services at Dhaleswar, Agartala and Amtali in response to requests from the Government of Tripura. "Rules for management of schools run by the R.K.Mission in the State of Tripura, 1990" have already been finalised and notified vide Education Department No.F.11(12-16)-DSE/89(L) dated 4.5.1990. The Government has agreed in principle to the payment of grants to R.K.Mission for starting and maintaining educational institutions, hostel at Amtali and a Vocational Centre with hostel (hostel for S.T.boys only) at Amtali. Adequate land for the institution has already been handed over and some non-recurring grants for construction of buildings has also been paid to the Mission Authorities.

2. The pattern of financial assistance for setting up of the institutions and its day to day management is given below so that the R.K.Mission authorities may set up the school right from the current academic session(1990-91):-

- i) The R.K.Mission will manage the schools as per provisions of notification issued vide No.F.11(12-16)-DSE/89(L) dated 4.5.90 regarding management of such schools.
- ii) The institutions referred to above will be eligible for 100% grants on non-recurring approved expenditure as an institution of excellence 'Sponsored by the State Govt.'
- iii) The school at Amtali will be an integrated high school from classes I to X. The school will be recognised by the State Govt. and may seek affiliation to CBSE.
- iv) The school classes may have about ~~around~~ 25 students per section.

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3. As regards recurring expenditure, the Government has approved the following pattern for acceptance of expenditure:-

i) The school will be entitled to number of teachers calculated as per formula indicated below:

No. of teachers admissible = No. of sections x 1 + Addl. teachers for Music/Arts/BUP etc. The pattern of non-teaching staff will be as for a grant-in aid school. However the following additionality is agreed to :

Additional staff : one each of music teacher, accompanist (tabalchi), art teacher, librarian, sorters, part-time Doctor, Compounder, Driver and Cleaner for each vehicle may be provided for the full scale school operation. Similarly, one Laboratory Attendant for each Laboratory and a maximum of 8 members of Class-IV including night guards and usual Clerical staff may be available to the full scale school. Subject teachers may be trained for SUEW work. The school may be entitled to appoint Honours/Post-Graduate teachers as may be required.

ii) Quantum of grant to meet contingent expenditure may be decided as per pattern of similar R.K.Mission Institutions situated at Narendrapur or Furulia in West Bengal or Deoghar in Bihar, as may be determined by the State Government.

iii) The school may have a maximum of 4 hostels in each of which 50 number of S.T. students will be accommodated. Each hostel may have a House Master. In addition there may be a kitchen supervisor and a maximum of 10 Class-IV staff (Cook, Mashalchi, Sweeper, Chowkidar, Night-Guard, Sick Room Attendant etc.) common for all 4 hostels.

iv) The pattern of assistance for resident tribal scholars may be similar to those for the boys sponsored to R.K.Mission Schools at Narendrapur/Furulia/Deoghar subject to approval of State Government.

v) Maintenance cost of transport vehicles of the school shall be paid by the Govt. at rate as may be fixed by the State Government.

- vi) Staffing pattern and expenditure towards stipend, cost of materials, maintenance of machineries and contingencies of Vocational Training Centre and its hostel will be decided by the Government in consultation with the Mission Authorities. There may be a hostel for 50 such trainees (Maximum intake) with a House Master and 3 Class-IV Staff (Cook, Mashalchil & Sweeper) at this Centre.
- vii) The complex may have for its administrative office 1-Accountant, 1-U.D.C, 2-L.D.C and 1-Peon.
- viii) Grant-in-aid to R.K.Mission may be paid by the Govt. on a quarterly basis. The mission will render to State Govt. on annual basis, its accounts showing the total income from all sources and the total expenditure as also the balance as on 31st March.
- ix) So long as the school does not operate at full scale, the entitlement of grants/staff will be proportionally reduced by the State Government.
